



## KEYNOTE A.M. SPEAKER & HONOREE

**DR. DORIS BROWNE** is President and CEO of Browne and Associates, Inc. (BAI), a certified service-disabled veteran and woman-owned health consulting company, which manages diversified health programs addressing the health status and disparities of national and international populations. BAI's mission is to provide education, training, disease prevention consultation and a comprehensive worksite wellness program to its clientele. 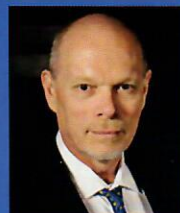
